What are Podcasts?

Podcasts are the downloadable equivalent of **radio shows** you may remember, but there is no video. You can listen immediately the podcast is available or some 5 + years later.

There are podcasts from politics, sports and culture to comedy—& everything in between. It's reported over **1 million podcasts** are now available.

How are Podcasts Structured?

Podcasts are structured like the old radio shows, with a host who interviews others about a specific topic.

By the end of a podcast, the listener generally achieves some insight, education about an issue, a good laugh or is just plain entertained. Podcast lengths vary from 5, 10, 15, 30, 60 mins.

Where Can I find Podcasts?

Literally everywhere! There is a plethora of podcasts on almost any topic and there are many places to download them. Some you pay for and some are **FREE**. Here at ARVCC we recommend just a few places to **download**.

- **Spotify** - Music & Podcasts
Listen for FREE if you have IOS devices or an Android tablet or Smartphone.
- **Apple's Podcasts** –
Apple have their own podcast app that offers a selection of amazing podcasts at the touch of a button.
- **Google Podcasts**—
If you don't use an iPhone, the easiest way to listen to a podcast is with your tablet via the Google Podcasts App. Another favourite source is
- **BBC Sounds**— *they're terrific!*
